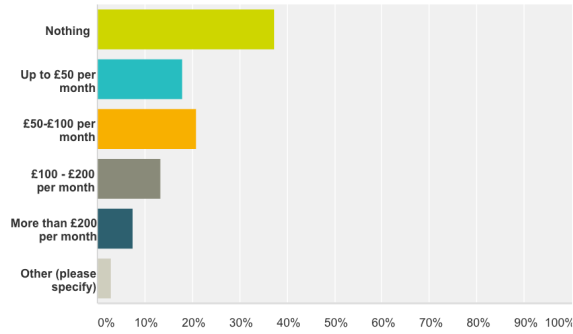


After-School Survey - Results, June 2016

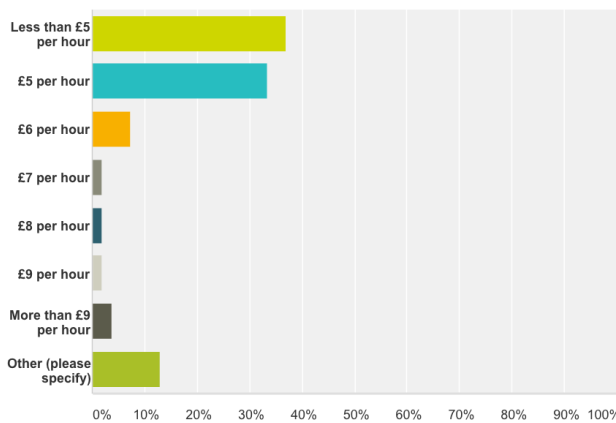
It is variable and has been much more at times but currently it is unlikely to be more than £50 per month per child

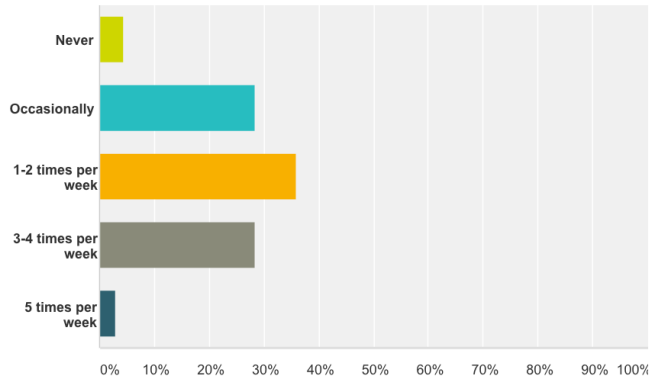

If it were available, how many times do you think you would use after-school care for your child/children at Hook Norton Primary School?

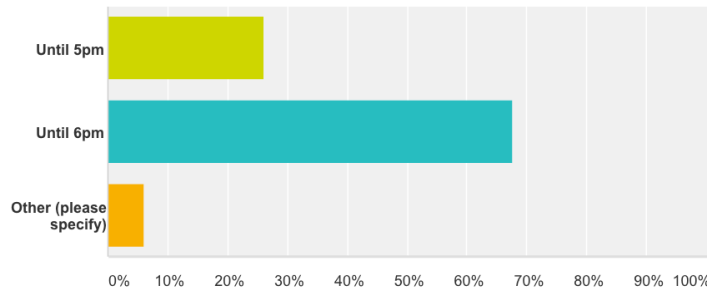

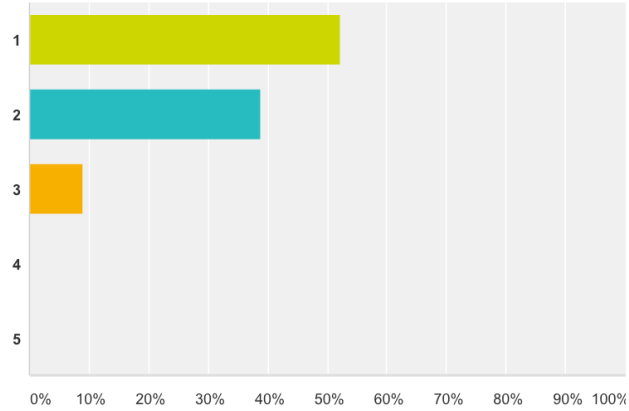

How many children do you have at Hook Norton Primary School?

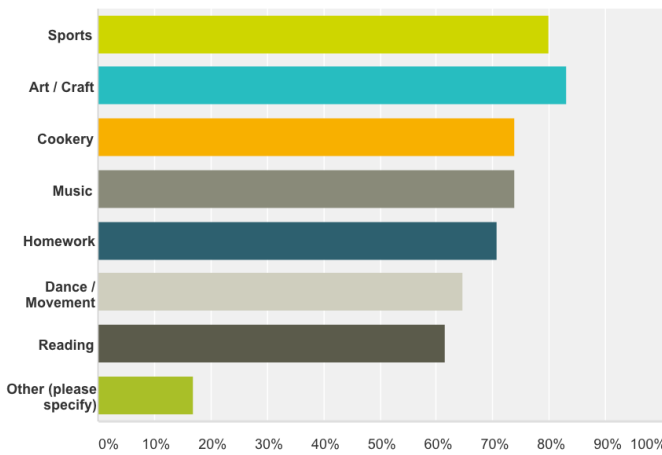
